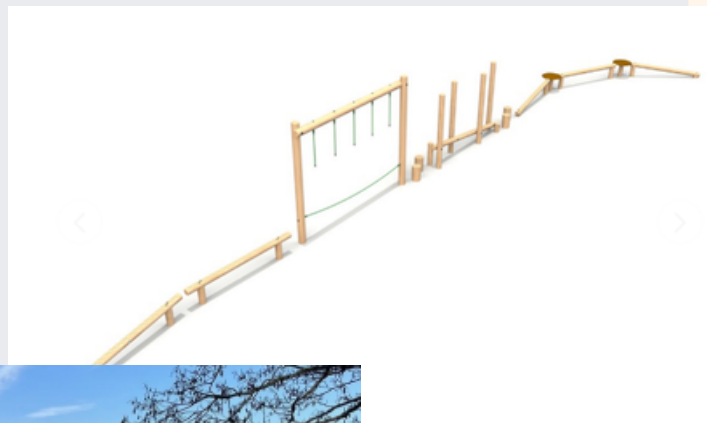




Fundraising

Thanks to your generosity, we are making significant progress towards our goal of raising funds for a fantastic trim trail for our Key Stage 2 children, to enhance playtimes.

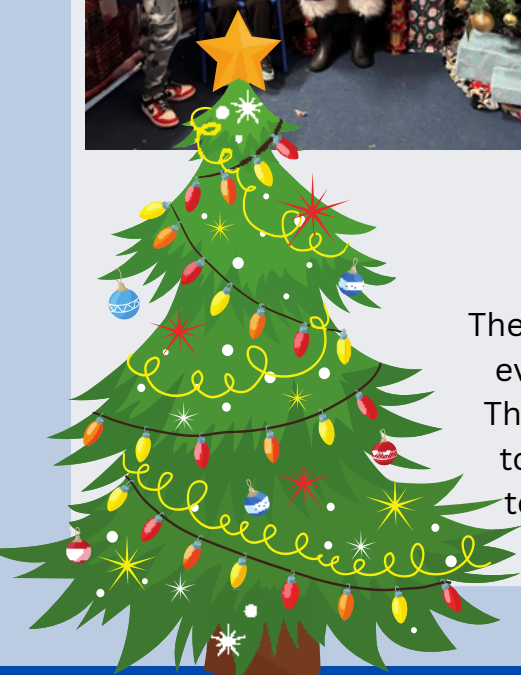
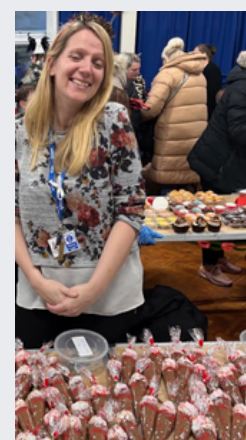
