Thank you for your continued support and have a lovely half term with your children.

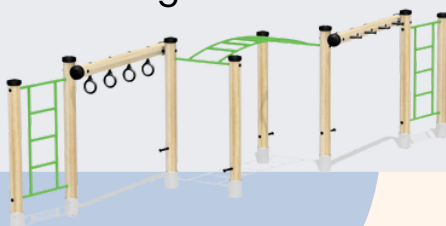

On Fridays HKR will be working with randomly chosen children with 100% for that week as a reward for their good attendance.

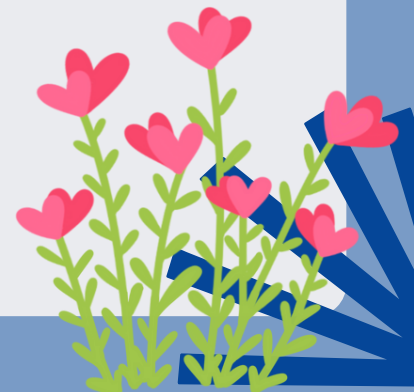


# After School Provision



Building work is underway in The Nest for our new after school provision. Over the holidays a kitchenette will be fitted, new flooring laid and an external door knocked through.

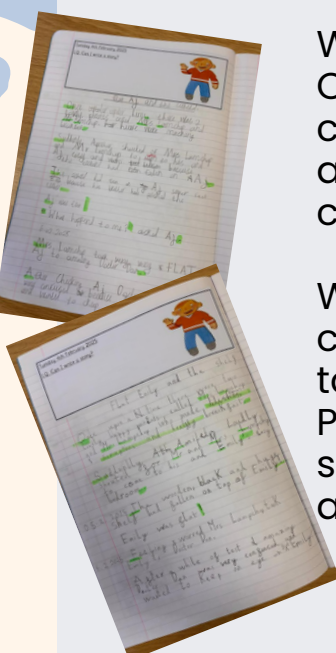
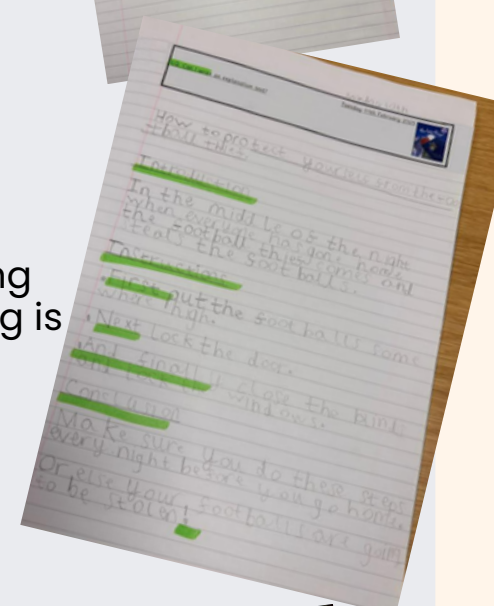
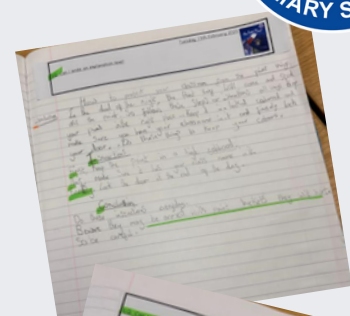

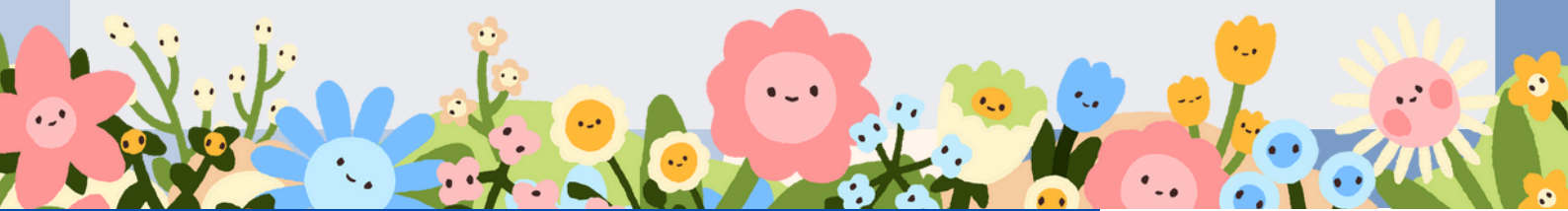


## HKR
